Parent/Teacher Pal

A parent/teacher pal will allow parents to become more familiar with all staff members in the Kindergarten and Mother's Day Out. This parent will be a secret pal to our staff by providing treats and goodies throughout the year and on special occasions. These items can be anything from a card, a pack of gum, a cup of coffee, or whatever you choose to do to brighten that person's day. We do ask that you remember you pal at least once a month. In May during Teacher appreciation week you may reveal yourself to your secret pal. We need 45 volunteers to help us make this a success!

How to become a secret pal:

- **Go to Carol's office the end of September and draw a name (this will be a blind draw)**
- **You will be given an information sheet that has your secret pal's favorite things**
- **Start sometime in September and end in May**

Teacher Snacks

We coordinate 4 mothers to provide enough food for all of our staff (45). You will be asked once during the school year to participate. We ask that you bring the food in the morning at drop off time. We put everything in our teacher kitchen for the teachers to have all day. Examples of food brought: bagels, muffins, coffee cake, fruit tray, dips, vegetable tray, and breakfast casseroles. We supply plates, napkins, and silverware. Drinks are optional. We usually have teacher snack twice a month.
