Dear Parishioner,

A key part of the discernment process to call a new rector at St. George's is to conduct a parish survey in order for the membership to share their hopes and concerns. The survey is designed to provide a picture of who we are as a church and what priorities are most important to parishioners as we move forward with the search. A few important notes regarding the survey delivery:

- The survey will be delivered through an email containing a unique web link on August 1st and will remain open through August 30th.

- If you would prefer to take the assessment using a paper copy, please stop by or call the church office **after August 1st**, and we will get one to you.

Please note that this survey is designed to be completed by each individual parishioner who is over the age of 16 and whose primary residence is in the state of Tennessee. Please do not complete the survey together or have one individual take it on behalf of the family. INDIVIDUAL INPUT is key to our gaining insight into overall perceptions and experiences.

The survey will take approximately 30 minutes to answer all of the questions and will need to be completed in one sitting. All survey responses are strictly anonymous.

Thank you for your willingness to be a part of the parish survey and for helping to build the future of St. George's. Our goal is 100% participation – we want to hear from every single parishioner during this important time and period of discernment.
