Please note: The Scriptures marked with an asterisk (*) are those to which we will be turning.

(1) Jesus. Who is He?

a. Known by many names (Heb 2:10; Isa 9:6; Rev19:16; Mat 1:21; Phil 2:5-11; Jn 1:1)

(2) Where did He come from?

a. Existed from the beginning (*Jn 1:1-4; 14)

b. Left His place in Godhead and came to earth (*Phil 2:5-11)

c. Was part of God's plan before the world was created (I Pet 1:18-20; Rev 22:13)

(3) Why did Jesus come to earth?

a. Some of the things He came to do and did: (Jn 21:25)

(1) To reconcile the world to God (II Cor 5:17-20)

(2) To establish the Kingdom of God on earth (Lk 1:28-33)

(3) To seek and save the lost (Luke 19:10)

(4) To bring us everlasting life (Jn 3:16-17)

(5) To deliver us from this present evil world (Gal 1:3-4)

(6) To destroy the works of the devil (I Jn 3:8)

(7) To do good and heal all who are oppressed of the devil (Acts 10:38)

(8) To heal the sick (I Pet 2:24)

(9) To preach the gospel to the poor, to heal the broken hearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, to preach the acceptable year of the Lord (Lk 4:18-19)

- (10) To give us life and life more abundantly (Jn 10:10)
 - (11) To offer His own blood to pay the penalty for our sins (Heb 9:12)
 - (12) To redeem us from the curse of the law so we could be blessed (Det 28; Gal 3:13-14)
 - (13) To bear witness unto the truth (Jn 18:37; Jn 14:6)
- b. His present and future work in us by His Holy Spirit
- (1) Indwells us (Lk 11:13; I Cor 3:16; I Cor 6:19-20; Ro 8:9-11)
 - (2) Transforms us (*I Jn 3:2; I Cor 15:51-58; *Ro 12:2; *II Cor 3:13-18)

(4) Who composes Jesus' Army?

a. Innumerable angels (Rev 5:11; Heb 12:22; Ps 148:2-5; Job 38:4-7; Heb 13:2)

b. Hierarchy

- (1) Seraphim, cherubim, living creatures, beasts, Is 6:1-3; Gen 3:24; Eze 1:5-28; Eze 10; Rev 4:6-9)
- (2) Archangels (Dan 8:16-17; Lk 1:26-38; Dan 10:13; Rev 12:7; Dan 12:1)
- (3) Angels or ministering spirits (Heb 1:13-14)
- (4) The saints (Rev 19:14; Mat 16:18)

c. Some of the things angels do

- (1) Instruct (Acts 10:3-8)
- (2) Deliver from danger (Acts 12:6-10; Acts 5:19-20; Ps 91:11-12; Ps 34:7)
- (3) Comfort, strengthen (Mt 4:11; Lk 22:42-43)
- (4) Deliver messages (Dan 9:21; Lk 1:25-38; Dan 12:1)
- (5) Receive at death (Lk 16:22)
- (6) War (Rev 12:7; Mat 26:53)
- (7) Minister to God's people (Heb 1:14)
- (8) Hearken to the voice of God's word (Ps 103:20)

(9) Active in tribulation and second coming of Christ (Matt 24:31; Mat 25:31-33; Rev)

(5) The scope and limits of Jesus' power and sphere of influence

- a. Name above every name (Phil 2:9-11)
- b. All power in heaven and in earth (Mat 28:18-20; Eph 1:19-23)
- c. Seated at right hand of God (Eph 1:19-23)
- d. Authority over hell and death (Rev 1:17-18; Heb 2:14-15)

(6) The good news for believers

- a. Jesus' victory is ours (*I Jn 5:4-5; Jn 14:16-17; I Cor 6:19-20; Eph 2:5-7)
