a. We are to submit to God and resist him (Jas 4:7)

(2) The Work of the Holy Spirit in and through us (Eph 3: 14-21; Gal 5:22-23; Jn 14: 4-5)

(3) God's love for us (Ro 5:6-8; I Jn 4:7-9)

(4) The glorious future provided to us by Jesus (Eph 1:15-18; I Thes 4:13-18; I Cor 15:51-58; Rev 21:1-5)

(5) Paul's view on this life (II Cor 4:16-18; II Cor 5:1-9)

(6) Paul's prayers for us (Eph 1:15-18; Eph 3:14-21)
