  - (1) God's covenant with Abraham paved the way (Gen 12-17)
  - (2) The Old Testament Scriptures prepared the world to receive Jesus (Lk 24:1-27; Col 2:16-17)

    - (4) Jesus in Gethesmane (Lk 22:39-46; Mat 26:39)
  - f. Jesus Crucifixion and burial (Mat 27:31-66; Mk 15:25-47; Lk 23:33-56; Jn 19:17-42)

(1) Fulfilled both Abrahamic and Old Covenants (\*Gal 3:13-14; Mat 5:17; Jn 1:29)

g. Jesus' resurrection (Mat 28:1-15; Mk 16:1-8; Lk 24:1-12; Jn 20 1:18)

(1) By power of Holy Spirit (Rom 8:11; Ep 1:19-23; Rom 8:11)

(2) Marked defeat of Satan and victory over death (\*Heb 2:14-15; I Cor 2:6-8; I Cor 15:12-58)

(3) Is our assurance of resurrection (I Thes 4:13-18)

- c. Resurrection of believers (I Cor 15:51-57; I The 4:13-18; \*Rom 8:18-23; I Cor 15:21-26; Rev 21:3-4)

(4) The New Covenant (Jer 31:31-33; He 8:8-12; He 10:16)

- a. First made with Israel and then extended to the Gentiles (Gal 3:26-30; Eph 3:1-7)
  - b. Law of love (\*Mat 22:35-37; Mk 12:28-34; \*Jo 13:34-35; Ro 5:5; Jo 7:38)
- (5) The kingdom (\*Mat 10:1-7; Isa 11:1-9; Isa 9:6-7; Zec 14:9)
- (6) The church (Ep 1:1-4; Mat 16:18; Mat 18:17)
- a. Promise of the Holy Spirit to indwell disciples (believers) (\*Jo 14:15-17; Jo 16:5-16)
  - b. Fulfillment of the promise (\*Jo 20:19-22; I Cor 6:15-20; I Cor 3:16-17)
    - (1) Enables us to keep the law of love (Ro 5:5; Jo 7:38)
