

MEDICAL RESPONSE TEAM

OVERVIEW

The medical response team supports the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by offering immediate aid and assistance for medical needs rising during worship services.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide first aid and assistance in the event of minor accidents or illnesses.
- Provide immediate medical care prior to the arrival of emergency responders.
- Ensure proper safety measures are taken for bodily fluids or other biohazards.
- Evaluate potential activities or situations that might present medical or safety concerns for participants and make recommendations.
- Add to the overall church safety and security program by offering suggestions for increased effectiveness.
- Respond to communication from your ministry leader in a timely manner.

RELATIONSHIPS

Work collaboratively with the safety team and in coordination with the safety team leader.

TIME COMMITMENT

- Approximately 1-2 hours each; 1-2 times per month. Each commitment, volunteers will be on call during a worship service, beginning 15 minutes before the service starts through 15 minutes after the service concludes.
- Participate in relevant trainings and drills scheduled by the safety team leader or staff member
