

OVERVIEW

The Bradford Gallery Displays team supports the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by facilitating the installation of gallery displays and exhibits designed to engage the Christian imagination and celebrate the fullness of God's kingdom through art.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Coordinate display details and logistics. Specific tasks include:

- Work with the clergy Curator for Bradford Gallery to install and remove art displays and exhibits.
- Get information such as images, art dimensions, artist bios, and other details for each exhibit.
- Facilitate the installation of each exhibit through creation and display of appropriate text and other pertinent information.
- Work with church sextons and artists to help with removal of art. May wish to get other parishioners to help with this task.

RELATIONSHIPS

The Displays team will work with the clergy Curator of the Bradford Gallery as well as with artists whose work will be featured in the gallery.

TIME COMMITMENT

Will vary with each exhibit. Estimated 15-20 hours prior to each exhibit for installation, and 6-10 hours afterward for removal.

Appreciation for art and artists, organizational and coordination skills, good communicator, creativity

RESOURCES AND TRAINING
