

COMMUNION CLASS ASSISTANT

OVERVIEW

The Meal & Snack Coordinator supports the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by assisting the Communion Class Teacher(s) to create a loving, caring environment for kids to build community and grow in knowledge of the sacraments of baptism, confession, and communion.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Attend the five sessions of Communion Class which occur between March and April during the Sunday School hour.
- Help facilitate games, small group discussions, etc. at the discretion of the class teacher(s).
- Be intentional in conversations with kids, building trust and fellowship among the group.
- Assist by helping to maintain classroom control.
- Attend the Communion Class retreat (3 hours on a Saturday morning) and help teachers with set-up and tear-down.
- Attend the first communion service on the Sunday following the retreat.
- Complete the required safe church training and background check.

RELATIONSHIPS

The Communion Class Assistant is served by the Director of Children's & Family Ministries who ensures the support needed to thrive in this role. This role serves within the children's ministries team, interacting mostly with Communion Class group leaders.

TIME COMMITMENT

1-hour per Sunday for 5 weeks. Participate in the 3-hour retreat on a Saturday morning and 1-hr Sunday first communion service.
