## OVERVIEW

The Sibling Baptism Class Volunteer supports the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by helping to create, produce, and maintain crafts and supplies for Sunday School, Childcare, Chapel, and Worship Bags.

## RESPONSIBILITIES

- Prepare craft and activities for Sunday School children aged 3-10 years as determined by the CFM staff; including cutting, copying, and sorting
- Laminate, cut, and collate worship bag activities as needed
- Check worship bags weekly to maintain tidiness and replace torn or missing pieces
- Help keep CFM craft space organized and supplies in stock
- Assist with occasional craft needs that include painting, cutting paper or felt, and sorting supplies

The Craft & Supplies Support Team is served by the Director of Children's & Family Ministries, who ensures the support needed to thrive in this role. This role serves with other members of the children's ministries team.
