

# KIDS CHAPEL VOLUNTEER

## OVERVIEW

A Kids Chapel Volunteer supports the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by helping to create a welcoming and safe environment for students from 1st through 6th grades to experience a simplified liturgy each Sunday during the 8:45 and 9:00am services.

## RESPONSIBILITIES

- Attend Kids Chapel services, arriving 15 minutes early.
- Check in students and visit with them until students from both services have arrived.
- Facilitate a respectful environment that allows students to hear the gospel message and homily.
- Assist in returning students to their families at the appropriate service.
- Learn the names of students and continue to speak to them if you see them at church or in the Nashville community.
- Communicate with the Associate Director of Children's & Family Ministries with availability or conflicts.
- Model the behavior we expect from students.
- Meet with the Associate Director of Children's & Family Ministries at agreed upon intervals for the purpose of spiritual care, leadership development, mentoring, and encouragement.

## RELATIONSHIPS

- An After-School Hangs Volunteer serves with the Associate Director of Children's & Family Ministries and students from grades 1 to 6.
- This role serves with other volunteers of the children's ministries team.

## TIME COMMITMENT

1 hour per week on Sunday mornings (usually 8:45-9:45am)

## SKILLS AND INTERESTS

Interest in building relationships with students in 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grades.

Leadership; modeling behavior that gains both respect of students but allows the students to feel safe and comfortable with the leader; time management and communication skills.

## RESOURCES AND TRAINING

- Safeguarding and background check required.
- Optional 1-hour training meeting with the Associate Director of Children's & Family Ministries for more comfort in the role.
