

# VBS ARTS & CRAFTS COORDINATOR

## OVERVIEW

The VBS Arts & Crafts Coordinator supports the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by helping to create, produce, and maintain crafts and supplies for the annual weeklong VBS summer camp for children in PreK (4) – 5<sup>th</sup> Grade.

## RESPONSIBILITIES

- Prepare craft and activities for VBS program aged 3-10 years as determined by the CFM staff; including cutting, copying, and sorting.
- Recruit a team of volunteers to help prepare materials in the weeks leading up to VBS.
- Let the staff know of any missing supplies that need to be ordered.
- Prepare several examples to use to show kids.
- Set out and oversee the craft station during the week of VBS.

## RELATIONSHIPS

- The crafts and supplies volunteer is served by the Director of CFM, who ensures the support needed to thrive in this role.
- This role serves with other members of the VBS team.

## TIME COMMITMENT

- 2-5 hours per week in the month leading up to VBS.
- Onsite during the 5 mornings of VBS (one is prep day and the remaining four are days when kids are onsite as well from 9am-12pm).

## SKILLS AND INTERESTS

Creative, organized, enjoys working with their hands, loves using hands-on materials to help children grow in faith.

## RESOURCES AND TRAINING

Materials are provided for all crafts and activities, orientation surrounding needs is provided.
