

VBS DECORATING VOLUNTEER

OVERVIEW

The VBS Decorating Volunteer supports the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by helping to plan, visualize, and execute the decorations for a weeklong, VBS summer camp.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Consult with the appropriate staff well before the event (typically between 4 and 12 months prior, depending on the event) to develop an implementation plan.
- Recruit volunteers to help set-up and take-down decorations.
- Using the year's theme, brainstorm decoration options that fit into the budget.
- Determine where materials can be purchased and the quantity needed.
- Determine if materials can be donated by parishioners, and if so, prepare communication materials to send out and where the materials can be stored.
- Be onsite on the Sunday and Monday before VBS to decorate hallways, Legacy Hall, and other areas as needed.

RELATIONSHIPS

- The VBS Decorating Volunteer is served by Director of Children's & Family Ministries, who ensures the support needed to thrive in this role.
- This role works with other members of the VBS team supporting this event.

TIME COMMITMENT

Four months (or more) of planning and preparation time, roughly two hours weekly. Sunday afternoon, and most of the day Monday before VBS to decorate.

SKILLS AND INTERESTS

Creativity, leadership, non-anxious presence, joy, and excitement about the event.

RESOURCES AND TRAINING

VBS planning notebook from previous events and orientation with the Dir. of CFM.
