## OVERVIEW

The VBS Hospitality volunteer supports the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by welcoming kids and adults into the church during the week of VBS summer camp.

## RESPONSIBILITIES

- Arrive early each day to help set up coffee and cookies for parents to linger over after drop-off.
- Greet children and adults arriving and direct them to the appropriate rooms as needed.
- Provide a warm welcome and presence for everyone walking through the doors.
- Clear away leftover coffee and cookies and determine what can be used the following day.
- Be confident in emergency response procedures and your role, as well as your team leaders' roles, in executing them.
- Complete required safe church training and background check.

## RELATIONSHIPS

- The VBS hospitality volunteer is served by Director of Children's & Family Ministries, who ensures the support needed to thrive in this role.
- This role works with other staff and volunteers supporting this event.

## TIME COMMITMENT

Duration of the event: four weekdays, from 8:30am-10am.

Hospitality, non-anxious presence, joy and excitement about the event.

Safe Church training. Orientation with Director of CFM and VBS Coordinator.
