

SUPPER GROUP COORDINATOR

OVERVIEW

The Supper Group Coordinator(s) support the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by creating opportunities for parishioners to enjoy small group fellowship through the year.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Work with Parish Life staff to organize supper groups at least twice a year (usually 1st and 2nd semester, as school calendar).
- Serve as lead contact for those interested in participating in a supper group.
- Put together small groups of 4-6 couples/individuals based on sign-ups and provide guidelines for gatherings: groups may meet in homes/restaurants/other settings for dinners once per month during fall and spring months (if interest is there, may include summer season as well). Groups are encouraged to meet at least once per month.
- Identify a coordinator for each group, who will be responsible for organizing monthly dinners among their group.
- Work with Communications staff to provide details about Supper groups both to recruit participants, as well as to inform parish of the opportunity.

RELATIONSHIPS

Works with the Parish Life staff, Communications director, and other ministry staff to ensure all parishioners are aware of the opportunity to participate in supper groups.

TIME COMMITMENT

Setting up groups should take place in late summer leading up to Fall semester, and in December leading up to spring semester, which may take several hours. Then minimal time commitment to communicate with groups on an ongoing basis.

SKILLS AND INTERESTS

Commitment to fellowship with parishioners; well organized; good communication skills.

RESOURCES AND TRAINING

Parish Life staff will help in recruitment of participants and will provide list of those who sign up.
