OVERVIEW

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Be prepared to help host a quarterly dinner for newcomers wanting to join St. George's.
- On the night of the dinner, meet caterer and team ahead of time in Bradford Gallery and serve as hosts for the dinner.
 - Work with STG 101 Hospitality Coordinator to ensure tables are all set and ready.
 - Work with STG 101 Hospitality Coordinator to help ensure dinner buffet and wine station are set up.
 - Wear name tag, greet guests warmly as they arrive, offer wine and conversation.
 - Help serve guests as they go through the buffet line.
 - Be willing to introduce yourself to the group if asked.
 - Remove dinner plates and place desserts on tables.
 - Once guests have adjourned to the sanctuary for instructed Eucharist, finish clearing tables. Once tables are cleared, you are done!

RELATIONSHIPS

- The STG Hospitality Team works with the STG 101 Hospitality Coordinator and the Director of Lay Ministry Engagement, and through this process engages with newcomers.
- This team works in communion with other welcome team members to create an inviting and approachable

TIME COMMITMENT

Approximately 2 ½ hours the night of each dinner

Warm and hospitable spirit; comfort conversing with strangers; enthusiasm for making others feel welcome
