

# SUNDAY STROLLING GREETER TEAM

## OVERVIEW

The Sunday Strolling Greeter Team supports the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by strolling the halls identifying, greeting, and helping Sunday morning newcomers or visitors who may need assistance finding childcare, a class, coffee, etc.

## RESPONSIBILITIES

- Wear provided name tag to identify yourself.
- Actively look for guests or newcomers who appear lost, confused, or simply out of place.
- Engage and visit with these newcomers, help them feel welcomed and comfortable, and escort them
- to any specific place they're looking for.
- Be aware of special events scheduled for the day; be prepared to provide details.
- If appropriate, have them complete a Connect card. Or encourage them to take one with them. Drop any completed cards into an offertory plate or "Connect card" box.
- Introduce them to a clergy member if the opportunity presents itself.
- Limit conversations with friends and others to ensure active presence and awareness of newcomers. Email greeter coordinator with helpful information learned from encounters with visitors or newcomers.

## RELATIONSHIPS

- In this informal ministry, the Sunday Stroller Greeter Team interacts with each other and with newcomers and visitors they encounter. They also communicate with the greeter coordinator as they have notes or info on anyone they've met.
- This team works in communion with other welcome team members to create an inviting and approachable environment, and to make St. George's feel like "home" to newcomers.

## TIME COMMITMENT

Sunday mornings during the Sunday school hour whenever you feel like it!

## SKILLS AND INTERESTS

Warm and inviting spirit; comfort conversing with strangers; enthusiasm for making others feel welcome.

## RESOURCES AND TRAINING

This team will work with the greeter coordinator but will primarily work independently.
