

SUNDAY TOUR GUIDES

OVERVIEW

The Sunday Tour Guides support the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by being posted strategically on Sunday mornings to assist newcomers or visitors in finding childcare, a class, coffee, etc. They also provide tours of the church campus when asked by the Director of Lay Ministry Engagement or the greeter coordinator, and to anyone expressing interest in a tour.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Wear provided name tag to identify yourself.
- Have campus maps handy and know where everything is.
- Be aware of special events scheduled for the day; be prepared to provide details.
- Actively look for guests or newcomers who appear lost, confused, or simply out of place. Ask them how you can help, and escort them to any specific place they're looking for. Provide them with a campus map.
- Limit conversations with friends and others to ensure active presence, awareness of, and accessibility to newcomers.
- Email greeter coordinator with helpful information learned from encounters with visitors or newcomers.
- Attend training whenever offered.

RELATIONSHIPS

- The Sunday Tour Guides interact with each other and with newcomers and visitors they encounter. They also communicate with the greeter coordinator as they have notes or info on anyone they've met.
- This team works in communion with other welcome team members to create an inviting and approachable environment, and to make St. George's feel like "home" to newcomers.

TIME COMMITMENT

One Sunday morning a month – approximately 2 hours each time

SKILLS AND INTERESTS

Warm and inviting spirit; comfort conversing with strangers; enthusiasm for making others feel welcome

RESOURCES AND TRAINING

This team will work with the greeter coordinator and the Director of Lay Ministry Engagement.
