OVERVIEW

The ROGUES (Retired Old Guys Unpaid Executives) Steering Committee supports the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by engaging active retirees in fellowship and in ministries such as mentoring, supporting, advising, and consulting using their lifetime of experience.

RESPONSIBILITIES

The ROGUES Steering Committee meets at regular intervals, with a focus on engaging retirees in this ministry and its offerings. Strategic planning occurs at these meetings, as well as specific plans for executing events. Examples of areas where the ROGUES come together are Crisis Response Team, mentoring St. George's Enterprise Ministry (SGEM) partners, and helping those facing financial, technical, or other challenges. Regular fellowship events are also planned by this group.
