

OVERVIEW

Music is an integral part of worship and St. George's Choir is committed to enhancing our shared experience by glorifying God through music. The choir is comprised of both professional singers and dedicated volunteers who work tirelessly to bring high-quality music and leadership to the worship experience at St. George's.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- The choir leads traditional worship services on Sunday morning, as well as Choral Evensong and other special services and concerts.
- The choir rehearses every Wednesday at 7:00-9:00pm during the academic year, as well certain special rehearsals prior to major events.
- For regular Sunday worship, members are expected to report for call time at least 30 minutes prior to the services in which they participate.
- Adult Choir members provide guidance and model professionalism for the Choristers of St. George's during services and events in which they participate.
- There are multiple social gatherings and celebrations scheduled throughout the year to which all choir members are invited.

RELATIONSHIPS

Adult Choir members report to the Director and Associate Director of Music Ministries. In addition, the Music Administrator oversees the distribution of sheet music and other music event support.

TIME COMMITMENT

Weekly commitment: 3-4 hours during academic year

Other special services, events and rehearsals will be scheduled as needed and communicated well in advance. In addition, there is an Adult Choir Retreat Weekend held every August at St. George's.

SKILLS AND INTERESTS

Experience singing in a choir is highly recommended. The music sung by St. George's Choir is primarily centered on traditional Anglican choral repertoire by composers ranging from the 16th century to modern times.
