

CHORISTER TRIP CHAPERONES

OVERVIEW

Music is an integral part of worship and St. George's Choir is committed to enhancing our shared experience by glorifying God through music. Chorister Trip Chaperones support the Music Ministry by providing supervision and support for off campus Chorister events.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Chaperones are needed for special Chorister events, including the Chorister Retreat Weekend (August) at Deer Run Camp & Retreat and periodic social events at Climb Nashville, Adventure Park, Cheekwood, etc.

- All chaperones must be 18 or older and complete the required safe church training.
- Be responsible for the care and supervision of Choristers while off campus.
- Assist the Director, Associate Director, and/or Music Administrator with planned activities as needed.
- Other duties as assigned.

RELATIONSHIPS

Chorister Trip Chaperones report to the Director of Music Ministries.

TIME COMMITMENT

Safe church training takes 1 hour, completed online at home at the time of your choosing.

Event time varies. In-town events typically require 2-4 hours. The annual retreat is an overnight event. Volunteers may serve for one event or multiple.

SKILLS AND INTERESTS

No prior experience or knowledge is necessary.

RESOURCES AND TRAINING

Safe church training is required by the church for any adult working with children or youth. Music Administrator will provide you with credentials for this online training and assigned training modules as needed. The work of this ministry is supported by the Music Ministries staff.
