

MUSIC USHERS & GREETERS

OVERVIEW

Music is an integral part of worship and St. George's Choir is committed to enhancing our shared experience by glorifying God through music. Music Ushers and Greeters support the Music Ministry by providing a welcoming presence to guests at music services and events.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Music event Ushers and Greeters serve as hosts for our special events and services throughout the year. Responsibilities vary based on the event, but may include:

- Welcome guests to music events and distribute bulletins or programs.
- If the Nave or other performance space is crowded, guide guests to available seats.
- Provide directions and other information about the campus to guests (e.g., location of restrooms, etc).
- Assist with bulletin/program preparation as needed (e.g., program inserts, etc).

RELATIONSHIPS

Music Ushers and Greeters report to the Music Administrator under the leadership of the Director of Music Ministries.

TIME COMMITMENT

Event times vary between 30 minutes and 2 hours.

Music Ushers and Greeters will be assigned to music services and events as needed based on their availabilities. Please arrive no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the event.

SKILLS AND INTERESTS

No prior experience or knowledge is necessary, only a welcoming attitude and an interest in supporting the Music Ministries of St. George's.
