

BOULEVARD BOLT VOLUNTEER

OVERVIEW

The Boulevard Bolt Volunteer supports the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" through the advanced planning and/or day-of-event activities for the annual Boulevard Bolt, a 5K Race on Thanksgiving Day which raises money for agencies working to eliminate homelessness in the Nashville community. The Boulevard Bolt is organized each year by St. George's Episcopal Church, Immanuel Baptist Church, and The Temple Ohabai-Sholom.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide hospitality and help create a safe race environment as directed by the Boulevard Bolt Coordinators. Needs range from race bib distribution, water service, shuttle drivers, parking management, etc.
- As requested, organize sub-set of volunteers
- Communicate activities and feedback for any improvements of Boulevard Bolt planning and activities with the Boulevard Bolt Coordinators.

RELATIONSHIPS

Works with the Boulevard Bolt Coordinators to ensure that ministry goals are met.

TIME COMMITMENT

Approximately 4 hours per month.
