

OVERVIEW

The Bus Drivers for Outreach Ministries support the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by volunteering to drive the St. George's 14-passenger bus for outreach activities, including Room in the Inn and Seniors Helping Others.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Transport guests in a safe manner.
- For any trip, driver will pick up keys from the church. After returning the vehicle, make note of gas and mileage on the provided form. Form and keys are returned to the church office.
- Bus Drivers must be approved before driving the church vehicle. The process requires that potential drivers:
 - provide a copy of a current driver's license to the Parish Administrative Officer (no commercial license is needed)
 - read and sign the Bus Guidelines as provided by the Parish Administrative Officer
 - authorize a Motor Vehicle Record Report requested by the church
 - provide a copy of current private motor vehicle insurance

RELATIONSHIPS

Bus drivers coordinate schedules directly with the ministry leaders or coordinators to identify schedule and instructions. Over time, relationships are built between the driver and those being transported – Room in the Inn guests, volunteers for outreach activities, etc.

TIME COMMITMENT

Varies based on ministry activities.

Room in the Inn trips are generally 1 hour (round trip to downtown Nashville), and Seniors Helping Others may be 2-4 hours total, with extended time to do ministry work between local destinations.

SKILLS AND INTERESTS

Hospitality, serving others in the community. Note: Bus Drivers for Room in the Inn must be male.

RESOURCES AND TRAINING

Once a driver has been approved, he/she will take an informal test drive with church staff to practice driving the bus. Volunteer will coordinate with Director of Outreach and leaders within individual ministries.
