

OUTREACH FUNDING COMMITTEE

OVERVIEW

The Outreach Funding Committee Member supports the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by participating in all activities of the Outreach Funding Committee including the grant application process, vetting of potential agency partnerships, and making funding recommendations to the SHARE Committee and vestry.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Attend all Committee meetings and participate in committee activities such as reviewing grant applications, visiting agencies, and determining final agency funding recommendations through a robust and fair process.
- Respond to communications from church staff and Outreach Funding Committee Chair in a timely manner (usually within 3 days).
- Communicate activities and feedback for any improvements with the Outreach Funding Committee Chair.

RELATIONSHIPS

The Outreach Funding Committee Member works directly with the Outreach Funding Committee Chair and Director of Outreach who coordinates staff support and communications for the team.

TIME COMMITMENT

Approximately 3 hours per week during grant application review and selection process (August-December).

SKILLS AND INTERESTS

Passion for supporting St. George's partner agencies to support joint success in our ministries. Demonstrates organizational skills, leadership, mercy, wisdom, discernment, and cultural and emotional intelligence.

RESOURCES AND TRAINING

Coordinates with the Outreach Funding Committee Chair for support, direction, and resources.
