

LIAISON to HOLY TRINITY EPISCOPAL

OVERVIEW

The Liaison to Holy Trinity Episcopal Church supports St. George's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by assisting in Holy Trinity's mission to serve the homeless through worship and shared meals.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Communicate with Church of the Holy Trinity (615 6th Ave. S) about the Church in the Yard program to co-host and identify any upcoming needs.
 - Work with Director of Outreach to recruit, equip and support sub-leaders in the areas of Hospitality, Food, Grounds/Building preparation and prayer ministers (or other ministries)
 - Work with Director of Outreach to provide sign-ups for volunteers to register to participate in the ministry.
 - Coordinates activities of sub-leaders and volunteer teams to ensure guests receive a hot meal during Church in the Yard once per month and that other ministry needs can be met as identified by the Rector of Church of the Holy Trinity (e.g. Healing Prayer).
- Work with the Director of Outreach and Mission Day Coordinator on opportunities for St. Georgians to serve at the Holy Trinity Episcopal Church campus on Mission Days.
- Responds to communications from church staff and volunteer team in a timely manner (usually within one week).
- Prepares communication drafts at least three weeks prior to routine events for staff review and placement in church communications.
- Helps us recognize the efforts of the team and individual members through St. George's communications and individual gestures of gratitude.
- Prepares a one-page report at the end of the year outlining number of volunteers and number of people served through St. George's partnership with Holy Trinity.

RELATIONSHIPS

- The Church of the Holy Trinity Liaison works directly with sub-leaders to ensure that mission goals are fulfilled.
- Works with the Director of Outreach who coordinates staff support and communications for the team.
- Provides leadership and interacts with other outreach teams including Room in the Inn ministries.

TIME COMMITMENT

Typical time commitment for organizing members and serving is 4 hours per month, year-round.

SKILLS AND INTERESTS

Passion for serving the homeless, organizational skills, leadership, mercy, wisdom, discernment, and cultural and emotional intelligence.

RESOURCES AND TRAINING

Coordinates with the Director of Outreach and Clergy with Outreach oversight for support, direction, and resources. Training includes annual retreat for outreach leaders.
