

OVERVIEW

The Jones Paideia Magnet School (JPS) Volunteer supports the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by providing meaningful relational support to students in kindergarten through 5th grade via opportunities identified by school administrators.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- The JPS Volunteer provides relational support to students at Jones Paideia Magnet School by volunteering to be a Literacy Tutor, Math Tutor, or Lunch Buddy.
- Bring any potential issues to the attention of the Jones Paideia Magnet School Coordinator
- Provide feedback to the JPS Coordinator on successes and potential process improvements.
- Responds to communications from church staff and volunteer team in a timely manner (usually within one week).

RELATIONSHIPS

The JPS Volunteer works directly with the JPS Coordinators to ensure that all program goals are met. Over time, special relationships are built between the volunteers and the students they serve.

TIME COMMITMENT

Preparation and on-site activities: approximately 1 hour per week during school year (September-May).

SKILLS AND INTERESTS

Passion for serving children in support of increased literacy, increased knowledge in math and for relationship building. Demonstrates organizational skills, leadership, mercy, wisdom, discernment, and cultural and emotional intelligence.

RESOURCES AND TRAINING

Coordinates with the JPS Coordinator for support, direction, and resources. Special training may be required by St. George's and/or Metro Public Schools before volunteers work with children.
