

MISSION DAY SUPPORT VOLUNTEER

OVERVIEW

The Mission Day Support Volunteers support the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by volunteering for at least one Saturday session held three times per year. During these Mission Days, St. George's volunteers learn more about the needs of our community and provide service to agencies working to meet those needs. Support Volunteers provide leadership for the Mission Day event, ensuring that the event runs smoothly and participants are ready to meet the needs of the community.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Volunteer to for a 5-hour session with St. George's partner agencies at Mission Days in March, September or December.
- Provide liability releases or skills assessment if requested by the agency.
- Promote Mission Day through informal/formal groups.
- Assist with T-shirts distribution to volunteers.
- Assist as designated Agency Project Lead at day of Mission Day to ensure volunteers arrive safely, photos are captured and transmitted to the Director of Outreach, and notification to church contact when event is complete.
- Respond to communications from church staff and Mission Day Coordinator in a timely manner (usually within 72 hours).
- Communicate successes and ideas for improvement of Mission Day planning and activities with Mission Day Coordinator.

RELATIONSHIPS

The Mission Day Support Volunteers work directly with the Mission Day Coordinator and Director of Outreach who provide support and communications for the team.

TIME COMMITMENT

One 5-hour shift on a Saturday between 1 and 3 times per year.

SKILLS AND INTERESTS

Passion for serving others through partner agencies. Demonstrates mercy, wisdom, discernment, and cultural and emotional intelligence.

RESOURCES AND TRAINING

Coordinates with the Mission Day Coordinator for support, direction, and resources.
