Daniel 9, continued

- I. Events between 69th and 70th week (Dan 9:26)
 - a. Messiah is “cut off” (*Dan 9:26; *Isa 53:8)
 - (1) Jews blindness to Jesus as Messiah explained (*Rom. 11:25; *II Cor. 3:13-16)
 - (2) Jews’ eventual recognition of Jesus as Messiah (*Zec 12:10)
 - b. Fall of Jerusalem in 70 AD (*Dan 9:26)
 - (1) Falls to Romans (“people of the “prince that shall come”)
 - (2) Is a type or preview of the tribulation
 - (3) Fall of Jerusalem described in New Testament (*Lk 19:41-44; Lk *21:20-24)
 - (4) Reason for the fall (*Lk 19:44; *Mat 27:20-25)
- II. Daniel’s 70th Week or The Tribulation (*Dan 9:27)
 - a. Begins with signing of 7yr treaty by anti-christ and “many”
 - b. Jesus describes tribulation (*Matt 24:4-21)
 - c. Abomination of Desolation (Mat 24:15; Dan 11:31; Dan 12:11: *II Thess 2:1-4)
 - d. The pre-determined end of the Antichrist (Rev 19:20)

 - b. Mystery of the Gentiles and Church Age (*Eph 3:1-7; *Isa 9:6; Lk 4:16-21; Isa 61:1-2)
