Please note: The scriptures marked with an asterisk (*) are those I will be reading aloud.

Daniel's Vision of Four Beasts, (cont'd from last week) (Dan 7)

- I. Daniel's description of Fourth Beast (*Dan 7:7-8)
 - a. Had 10 horns (*Dan 7:7)
 - b. Little horn (anti-christ) emerges from the ten (*Dan 7:8)
 - c. Judgment and demise of ant-christ (*Dan 7:9-12)
 - d. Kingdom given to Jesus (*Dan 7:13-14)
- II. The Interpretation of Daniel's First Vision (*Dan 7:15-28)
 - a. Four beasts are four kings (kingdoms) which shall arise out of the earth (*Dan 7:17)
 - b. Beast #4 is the 4th kingdom (Revived Roman Empire) and shall devour the whole earth (*Dan 7:23)
 - c. Ten horns are ten kings who come out of this kingdom (*Dan 7:24)
 - d. Another horn (anti-christ) shall rise after them and shall subdue three of the kings (*Dan 7:24)
- III. Anti-christ's attempts to set up his own kingdom (*Dan 7:25)
- IV. Anti-christ is defeated and is destroyed (*Dan 7:26)
- V. Jesus Sets Up His Kingdom on Earth (*Dan 7:27-28)

Daniel Chapter 8 (Note: Language changes back to Hebrew from Aramaic or Syriac which began in Chapter 2:4)

I. Daniel's Second Vision (Dan 8)

- a. Ram with two horns (*Dan 8:3-4)
- b. He goat with one notable horn (*Dan 8:5-7)
 - (1) He goat's horn broken and replaced by four horns (*Dan 8:8)
 - (2) "Little horn" emerges from one of the four horns (*Dan 8:9-14)

II. Interpretation of Second Vision

- a. Gabriel sent to give Interpretation (*Dan 8:15-19)
- b. Ram with two horns are kings of Media and Persian (vs 20)
 - (1) Parallels chest and arms of statue dream (Dan 2:32, 39)
 - (2) Parallels the Second Beast of Daniel's vision of bear (Dan 7:5)
- c. He goat is the king of Greece (*Dan 8:21)
 - (1) Parallels belly and thighs of statue dream of Nebuchadnezzar (Dan 2:32,39)
 - (2) Parallels the Third Beast of Daniel's vision of leopard (Dan.7:6)
- d. Great horn between eyes is the first king of Greece (Alexander the Great) (*Dan 8:21)
- e. Four horns come up after the great horn is broken (kingdom divided among Alexander's four generals at his death) (*Dan 8:22)
- f. "Little horn" emerges (*Dan 8:23-25) Who is he?
 - (1) Antiochus IV of Syria?
 - (2) The anti-christ?
- g. Daniel's vision to be shut up until far into future (*Dan 8:26)
- h. Daniel's reaction to vision (*Dan 8:27)
