Phoebe's Meals supports the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ," by delivering up to six meals to a fellow parishioner during a time of need. The group uses the website [TakeThemAMeal.com](http://TakeThemAMeal.com) to sign up to deliver the meals. The meals can be homemade, store bought, taken from the freezer at the church (Chefs on Call), or delivered using a delivery service like Uber Eats or Grub Hub.
