



## OVERVIEW

The Sunday Driving Ministry supports the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by arranging transportation for church members who are unable to drive and need a ride to Sunday Services.

## RESPONSIBILITIES

- Serve as or arrange for a contact person for church member to call and ask for transportation assistance.
- Each driver must provide the Parish Administrative Officer valid TN Driver's License and proof of current auto insurance.
- When a need arises, the Coordinator will match church member with approved drivers.
- Maintain a list of drivers who are willing to use their personal vehicles to provide transportation.
- Maintain a list of parishioners who would like to come to Sunday Services.
- Invite feedback of how the ministry is working to provide a much-needed service to those wanting to come to church.

## RELATIONSHIPS

The Coordinator reports to the Director of Pastoral Care who ensures the Coordinator and drivers have the support they need. Through these requests, the coordinator will form relationship with church members at St. George's—including those who may not be able to participate often due to a lack of transportation.

## TIME COMMITMENT

The time varies with requests, no more than 1 – 2 hours per month.

## SKILLS AND INTERESTS

Serving others, building one-on-one relationships, organization, caring, and friendship.

- Valid TN DL
- Reliable car (preferably a sedan)
- Proof of Car insurance
