II. The Seven-sealed Book (scroll) in God's hand (*Rev 5)

- (a) No man found worthy to open, nor to read, nor to look upon the book (scroll) or to open the seals (*Rev 5:3-4)
- (b) Jesus as the lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David prevails to open the book and to loose the seals (*Rev 5:5)
- (c) Jesus as the lamb with seven horns and seven eyes takes the book from the right hand of God (*Rev 5:6-7; II Sam 22:3; Ps 18:2: *I Pet I 18-20; Jer 32:9-14)
 - (1) Reason man (Jesus) has to take book (Rev 5:3-4; Ps 24:1; Gen 1:26; Ps 115:16; Phil 2:5-11; I Pet 3:22; Matt 28:18; Rev 11:15)
- (d) The "New Song" (*Rev 5:8-10; Rev 1:6; Rev 20:6)
- (e) Much Rejoicing in Heaven (*Rev 5:11-14)
