RESPONSIBILITIES

The Caring Connections volunteer is assigned one or two special parishioners who can be contacted with phone calls, in-home visits and cards during the year. The volunteer will receive a pack of greeting cards that can be picked up the pastoral care office. The volunteer gives a monthly report to Karen Lackey, Coordinator of Caring Connections.

RELATIONSHIPS

Friendships are formed between the Caring Connection volunteer and the parishioner. The care that is shown to the infirm or homebound is a ministry of pastoral love and concern of others.

TIME COMMITMENT

Time varies but no more than 1.5 hours per month
