

OVERVIEW

The Senior Ministry Flower Guild supports the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by providing floral décor for senior fellowship and learning events throughout the year. This role provides an important role in making guests feel the fellowship and love of St. George's Church.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- In collaboration with the Director of Pastoral Care, plan décor to support the vision of the event and secure budget for flowers.
- Check vase inventory if using church vases and create shopping list of flowers to be used.
- Invite others to support by shopping, preparing, and arranging the flowers.
- Use floral room near Legacy Hall to arrange flowers, store in floral cooler as needed.
- Once event is over, floral arrangements may be used at another event. Check with Director of Pastoral Care. The flowers can be stored in the floral cooler (large bucket).
- Church vases (if used) can be washed in the upstairs office dishwasher or by hand in church kitchen.
- Storage of vases will be determined by Director of Pastoral Care.

RELATIONSHIPS

The Senior Ministry Flower Guild will be supported by the Director of Pastoral Care and Senior Ministries.

TIME COMMITMENT

Varies, depending on event and how many arrangements are needed, typically 12 – 20 events a year. The main need for floral centerpieces is for the Prime Time Speaker Series which is typically held on the third Thursday of each month.

SKILLS AND INTERESTS

Flower arranging, event décor, behind-the-scenes preparation.

RESOURCES AND TRAINING

Director of Pastoral Care will supply needed support.
