OVERVIEW

The Prime-Time Welcome Hosts supports the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by offering a warm, welcoming impression to those attending the Prime Time Speaker Series events. Hosts help foster relationships among seniors at St. George's and their guests, building a sense of community and belonging.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Arrive 15 minutes early to welcome guests
- Assist attendees with payment and check-in.
- Encourage guests to make a nametag
- Encourage guests to sign up for the next month's event.
- If the guests are new to St. George's, provide a connect card located on the nametag table and help direct to restrooms as needed.
- Provide a brief verbal/email report to Director of Pastoral Care of any needs, ideas, concerns for next event.

RELATIONSHIPS

By volunteering in this role, hosts will build relationships among an active group of seniors at St. George's, as well as visitors. Will work closely with other church members and Director of Pastoral Care.

TIME COMMITMENT

Approximately 30-45 minutes per event. Volunteer duties are complete once all guests have check in.

SKILLS AND INTERESTS

Enjoyment of social events; enjoy speaking to newcomers

RESOURCES AND TRAINING

Director of Pastoral Care will supply needed support.
