

SENIORS TRIP COORDINATOR

OVERVIEW

The Senior Trip Coordinator supports the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by developing opportunities for the senior church family to experience fellowship outside the church on day/field trips.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Work closely with Director of Pastoral Care planning coordinating details of a proposed field trip with support and resources.
- Communicate with the senior ministry leadership and committee for ideas of what type of trips would appeal to the seniors.
- Develop an itinerary in approval of Senior Ministry leadership, Parish Administrator Director, and Director of Pastoral Care.
- Identify needed sign-up information/registration and trip details.
- Ensure all budgeting for trip has been approved.
- Engage a prayer team with those attending to pray before trip and during the trip.
- Provide clear and consistent messaging to registered guests before, during and completion of trip.
- Provide a short wrap up report of the trip to Director of Pastoral Care.

RELATIONSHIPS

- The field trip coordinator reports to Director of Pastoral Care.
- Coordinator(s) provide important leadership to seniors participating in the field or day trip.

TIME COMMITMENT

Varies, depending on the trip. Strong support by Director of Pastoral Care.

SKILLS AND INTERESTS

Director of Pastoral Care will provide needed support and suggestions on items such as transportation needs, budget needs, safety needs, determination of trip locations, etc.
