



OVERVIEW

The committee for the Ladies' Lenten Lunches supports the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by coordinating fellowship and learning events for women of the church and community during Lent. These lunches have historically had 50-60 women in attendance.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Work with the committee chair(s) and will appropriate staff to plan and execute 3-5 lunches during the Lenten season.

Specifically, offer support in coordinating one or more of the following:

- Speakers
- Lunch caterers
- Centerpieces
- Speaker gifts
- Volunteering or recruiting volunteers to host a check-in table and a sign-up table for the 2 Sundays prior to the first lunch
- Recruiting attendees and promoting the event

RELATIONSHIPS

The Ladies' Lenten Lunch Coordinator(s) works together with staff, speakers, caterers, and other volunteers.

TIME COMMITMENT

Estimated 2-3 hours in the 3 months prior; 3 hours weekly during the weeks of the lunches

SKILLS AND INTERESTS

Event planning; organization; coordination; recruiting volunteers; logistics; collaboration with staff

RESOURCES AND TRAINING

Director of Pastoral Care additional staff involved with lay ministry events will supply needed support.
