- Be present at retreat as needed.

RELATIONSHIPS

The Retreat Committee works with each other, the Retreat Leader(s), Director of Pastoral Care, and appropriate clergy. Relationships with retreat attendees will be formed as well.

TIME COMMITMENT

Planning and preparation time varies with length and location of retreat. The duration of the actual retreat is usually 1 – 2 days twice a year.

SKILLS AND INTERESTS

Serve in community with varying levels of detail. Organized, discerning, faithful and likes to support others in their faith journey. Ability to coordinate details and spend within a set budget.

RESOURCES AND TRAINING

The work of this team will be supported by the Retreat Leader(s), Director of Pastoral Care and clergy.
