

WOMEN'S RETREAT LEADER

OVERVIEW

The Women's Retreat Leader(s) support the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by helping nurture a retreat environment where women have a meaningful experience and grow closer to God and each other.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- The Retreat Leader(s) work with the priest presiding over the women's retreats and the Director of Pastoral Care to help plan location, cost, schedule, and activities.
- The Retreat Leader(s) form a retreat committee to support the activities of the retreat
- A budget is approved by the Parish Administrator. The Priest and Director of Pastoral Care work closely with the Retreat Leader(s) to budget funds for venue and materials.
- A sign-up description will be set up in Realm, cost as needed.
- Responsible for organizing the schedule, food, and supplies needed for retreat.

RELATIONSHIPS

The Retreat Leader(s) report to the Priest and Director of Pastoral Care; they provide support needed to plan a thriving and meaningful retreat. This role covers many details and requires excellent communication skills with attendees.

TIME COMMITMENT

Planning and preparation time varies with length and location of retreat. The duration of the actual retreat is usually 1 – 2 days twice a year.

SKILLS AND INTERESTS

Serve in community with varying levels of detail. Organized, discerning, faithful and likes to support others in their faith journey. Ability to coordinate details and spend within a set budget.

RESOURCES AND TRAINING

The work of this team will be supported by the Director of Pastoral Care and clergy.
