



OVERVIEW

Lectors support the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by reading and sharing Scripture at worship services.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Study and prepare Scripture to be read, as provided by the worship volunteer scheduler.
- Arrive at scheduled service 15 minutes early. Speak to the vergers or priest leading the service to assure them you are present, and make sure a printed copy of the reading is on the lectern before the services begins.
- During the appropriate time of the service, read the lesson to the congregation with a focus on reading loudly and clearly (this is not a theatrical reading).
- Attend trainings as offered.

RELATIONSHIPS

Lectors work with the clergy liaison for worship, Lay Eucharistic Ministers (LEMs), Vergers, and other worship leaders.

TIME COMMITMENT

1-2 commitments per month

SKILLS AND INTERESTS

Comfortable reading in public; enjoys facilitating meaningful worship

RESOURCES AND TRAINING

Lectors will be scheduled by the worship leader scheduler and trained by the clergy liaison for worship.
