

OVERVIEW

Ushers support the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by giving a warm and welcoming first impression of the church. They are responsible for guiding parishioners and visitors alike through the movements of the service.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Become proficient in specific duties for service(s) where you will be serving, whether the 8:45am or 11am traditional services in the Sanctuary, or The Table service in Legacy Hall.

Before service:

- Arrive 20 minutes prior to service, wearing nametag.
- Greet parishioners and visitors, distribute bulletins, and help them to find seats as needed.

During Service

- Assist latecomers in finding seats.
- Discreetly take attendance at the beginning of the sermon and complete usher attendance slip.
- Per specific instructions per service, pass the Offertory plates, take forward to priests, and transmit money to church office as instructed.
- Per instructions and as needed, usher attendees forward to receive the sacrament.

RELATIONSHIPS

Ushers work closely with each other, clergy, worship leaders, and every person who attends a service.

TIME COMMITMENT

2 hours per service, once or twice a month

SKILLS AND INTERESTS

Welcoming spirit: enthusiasm for helping others feel welcome; comfort conversing with and assisting others

RESOURCES AND TRAINING

Ushers will be trained prior to service.
