



## OVERVIEW

The Young Adult Committee supports the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by planning and executing events and opportunities focused on young adults, and by nurturing their spiritual growth. Young adults are generally perceived to be individuals between the ages of 21 and late 30s, who do not yet have children.

## RESPONSIBILITIES

The Young Adult Committee will meet at regular intervals as determined, with a focus on meeting the spiritual, fellowship, engagement, and pastoral needs of young adults in the parish. Strategic planning will occur at these meetings, as well as specific plans for executing events. Examples of opportunities planned are fellowship events, social outings, special speakers, retreats, and other gatherings. Details planned will include focus, time and date, location, speaker if desired, budget, food, etc. for each opportunity.

## RELATIONSHIPS

This committee welcomes all who wish to participate, and will work closely with each other, staff, clergy, and young adults involved in and attending opportunities planned.

## TIME COMMITMENT

Will vary. Up to one regular meeting per month, plus time spent supporting specific events/opportunities.

## SKILLS AND INTERESTS

Organization, thoughtful ideas on how to best serve and engage other young adults, willingness to "own" and execute events.
