

OVERVIEW

The Youth Event Volunteer supports the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by assisting our Youth Staff in event preparation and execution to create a nurturing environment where students can grow in their relationships with one another, our volunteers, and Jesus Christ.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Serve at one or more of youth events throughout the year (e.g. Pancake Supper, Fall Confirmation Retreat, Amazing Race, Harvest Dinner, 7th Grade trip, etc.)
- Communicate with youth staff to learn event schedule, volunteer roles, arrival/departure times, skill set, etc.
- Be a godly example to our students in words and actions.
- Support our Youth Staff with diligence and commitment to excellence.
- Creating a welcoming and safe environment for students who attend by engaging in conversation, building relationships with them, learning names and making them feel loved.
- Engage with students, parents, and/or staff to grow in relationship with them.
- Communicate feedback and input about successes and areas for improvement

RELATIONSHIPS

Depending on which events the Youth Event Volunteer is working, there will be a variety of people they may work closely with, but predominantly they will communicate with our Youth Ministry Staff to learn what is expected of them and provide feedback.

TIME COMMITMENT

Varies based on event – may be as little as one hour to a multi-day event.

SKILLS AND INTERESTS

A sincere faith in Jesus; a desire to serve our students and create an excellent space for them to grow. Good listener, interest in getting know youth. Many events may require specific skills such as food prep, decorating, leading worship, setting up chairs, driving students, etc.
