

## OVERVIEW

The volunteer Sunday School teacher supports the church's mission to "receive, live, and share the abundant life of Jesus Christ" by teaching lessons each Sunday to our youth so that they might better understand who God is and how he loves them.

## RESPONSIBILITIES

- Sunday School Teachers are needed for 7th Grade, 8th Grade (Confirmation), and High School Sunday School classes.
- Look over each week's Sunday School lesson plan prior to class and be prepared to teach it.
- Arrive to your Sunday school classroom each Sunday at 9:50am to ensure that everything is set up and all materials are present.
- Teach through the lesson plan in an engaging way for students to help them learn about the given topic.
- Facilitate discussion by asking and answering students' questions.
- Invest relationally with students during the Sunday school hour, learn names, and make them feel welcomed and loved!
- Clean up classroom and place all materials together.
- Communicate feedback and input about how classes and students' well-being with Youth Ministry staff.

## RELATIONSHIPS

- Sunday School teachers will work closely with the Director of Youth Ministries who will communicate weekly lesson plans and other details.
- Sunday School teachers will also work closely each Sunday with their respective Sunday School Assistants who will take attendance, aid in classroom management, occasionally fill in, and facilitate discussion.

## TIME COMMITMENT

Weekly commitment is approximately 2 hours – one hour of preparation and one hour for Sunday school. Teachers commitment to serving for a school year (September to May), with an average of 3 to 4 Sundays per month. (Teachers are excused on Combined Sunday School weekends or holiday breaks where there is no Sunday School).

## SKILLS AND INTERESTS

Teaching, spending time with students, building relationships, knowledge of Scripture, consistency, collaboration with staff.

## **RESOURCES AND TRAINING**

There will be a mandatory volunteer training for youth volunteers in August, and all youth volunteers must complete Safeguarding God's Children.
